Kimley-Horn Moving U.S. Headquarters to Highwoods-Owned One Bank of America Plaza in CBD Raleigh

55,000 Square Foot Long-Term Lease Signed New Customer for Highwoods

Raleigh, NC – September 23, 2015 - Highwoods Properties, Inc. (NYSE:HIW) announced that Kimley-Horn, one of the country's premier design consulting firms, is moving its U.S. headquarters to Highwoods-owned One Bank of America Plaza in downtown Raleigh. Kimley-Horn will be occupying 55,000 square feet in the building the Company acquired in September 2014.
